Perenne, glaucovirens; caulis nanis, a basi intricatim ramosissimis, ramis demum apice spinescentibus; foliis radicalibus rosulatis, sinuato-dentatis vel pinnatifido-lyratis, caulinis linearibus, saepius integris; capitulis in dichotomiis sessilibus, solitariis, rarius 2—3 aggregatis, terminalibus paucis, in apice ramulorum non incrassatorum insidentibus; involuci glabriuscili phyllis externis ovatis, obtusis, internis linearibus, triplo longioribus; pappo setoso-subpaleaceo, achenio 8—10 plo breviore.

Perennis; radice crassa verticali; foliis radicalibus, rosulatis, glabris vel ciliatis, saepe pulverulentis, in segmenta rhomboidea, dentata vel incisa runcinatim pinnatipartitis; scapis monocephalis, folia superantibus, fructiferis vix incrassatis; calyculi squamis involucro triplo brevioribus; involuci phyllis oblongo-linearibus, fructiferis stellatim expansis; acheniis marginalibus compressis, exalatis, oblongo-linearibus, striatis, pappo paleolato brevissimo, ceteris oblongo-linearibus, late alatis, costatis, margine scabris, pappo radiis numerosis, aliis setiformibus, aliis basi paleaceo-dilatatis constante superatis, intimis anguste linearibus, exalatis. — Planta graeca, saltem illa e Naxos, foliis crassiusculis, glaucovirentibus, segmentis parvis, dentatis, involuci phyllis latioribus et pappi setis basi parum paleaceo-dilatatis, magis piliformibus, ab occidentali discedit et subspeciem propriam — *graecam* — sistere videtur.
