HUPEH: Ichang and immediate neighbourhood (*A. Henry*!).

Characterized by the leaves being borne on long petioles, otherwise closely allied to *Crepis japonica*.

### 5. *Crepis prenanthoides*, Hemsl., n. sp.

*Herba* biennis vel perennis, 2–3 ped. alta, glabrescens, caulis subsimplicibus striolatis. *Folia* membranacea, petiolata, cito glabrescentia, subtus glauca, remote calloso-denticulata; radicalia longe petiolata (petiolo 6 poll. longo), hastato-cordata, 3–4 poll. longa; caulina breviter petiolata, alte pinnatifida, segmentis anguste lanceolatis, longe acuminatis. *Capitula* pauca, laxe paniculata, graciliter pedunculata, 12–15-flora; involucri calyculati bractæ 7–8, leviter puberulæ, angustæ, obtusæ, coloratæ, pappo paullo breviores; receptaculum nudum. *Achænia* fusco-atra, nitida, fusiformia, pappum æquantia, apicem versus albida, multistriata, minutissime puberula, sursum attenuata, estriata; pappus albus, mollis, diu persistens.

SZECHUEN: Chung city (*Faber*!). Herb. Kew.

The limits of the genera *Crepis*, *Lactuca*, and *Prenanthes* are so badly defined, and perhaps indefinable, that it is difficult to determine in which to place some species; but the erostate achenes and soft, white, apparently persistent pappus point to *Crepis* for the present species, though the smooth tapering tip of the achenes is the next thing to a beak.
