

Calamus pauciflorus T. Evans *et al.* non Ridl. renamed
Calamus oligostachys T. Evans *et al.*

Due to an oversight we recently described a new species under a pre-occupied name (Evans *et al.* 2000). The name, *Calamus pauciflorus*, had already been applied by Ridley to a Malayan plant now synonymised with *C. filipendulus* Becc. Below we propose a new, available name for the plant we described. FRCL refers to the collection of the Forestry Research Centre, Vientiane.

***Calamus oligostachys* T. Evans, K. Sengdala, O. V. Viengkham, B. Thammavong & J. Dransf. nom. nov.** Typus: Laos, Bolikhamxay Province, Thaphabaat Distr., Ban Pakleuk, *Khamphone Sengdala* 324 (holotypus K, isotypus FRCL).
